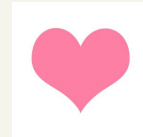
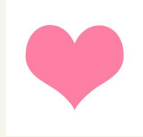

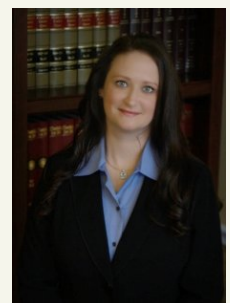

Recipe of the Month: Baked Artichoke Dip

Ingredients:

- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 14 oz. can artichoke hearts, well drained (marinated or not, as you wish)
- 10 oz. pkg. frozen chopped spinach, thawed, well drained
- 1 red bell pepper, chopped
- 1 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese

Preparation:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix mayonnaise and Parmesan cheese. Stir in artichokes, spinach and bell pepper. Place in 1 quart ovenproof casserole and sprinkle with Monterey Jack cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for 15-20 minutes until heated and bubbly and cheese is melted. Serve with baguette slices, crackers or pita crisps.

Teens face the greatest risk of crashing during their first year of driving.

One out of every five licensed 16-year-olds will be in a vehicle crash.

motor vehicle crashes in 2007. That is 306 too many.
