Dellutri Law Group 12 Year Anniversary Party

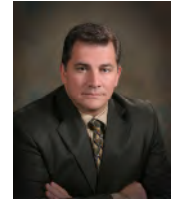

Fun and Easy Recipe of the Month: Berry Orange Sorbet

Ingredients:

1 1/4 cups water*1/2 cup sugar*1 1/2 cups fresh or thawed raspberries*1 cup orange juice*2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice



Instructions:

1) In small saucepan, combine 1 cup of water and 1/2 cup sugar. Bring liquid to simmer. Continue simmering for 3 minutes, stirring often, until the sugar dissolves. Remove pan from heat and let syrup cool. 2) Put berries and remaining 1/4 cup water into the bowl of food processor. Puree 30 seconds. Strain puree to remove seeds. 3) In a pitcher, stir together the cooked syrup, orange and lemon juices, and seedless berry puree. Pour the mixture into ice-cube trays and freeze until firm (about 6 hours). A pitcher or bowl with a spout will make filling the ice-cube trays easier. 4) When ready to serve, put the fruit cubes into food processor and pulse them to make smooth sorbet.
