Ingredients:

- *11-oz. pkg. Nestle Tollhouse Butterscotch Morsels
- *3/4 cup peanut butter
- *1 can (8.5 oz.) Chow Mein noodles
- *3 1/2 cups mini marshmallows

Directions:

LINE trays with wax paper. MICROWAVE morsels in large, uncovered, microwave-safe bowl on MEDIUM-HIGH power for 1 minute; STIR, The morsels may retain some of their original shape. If necessary, microwave an additional 10- 15 seconds, stirring just until morsels
