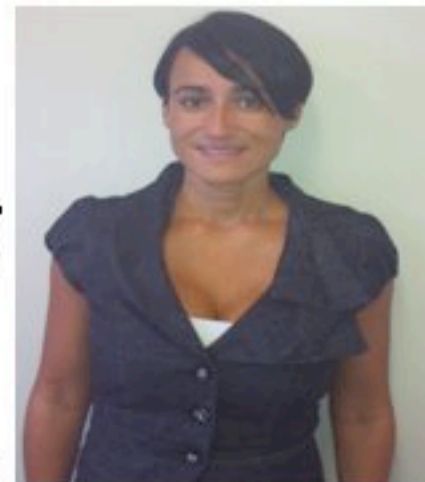
Congratulations to Attorney Amanda Downing !
